Follow the steps below to correctly configure your Tazer JL Mini settings to facilitate the installation of the Atlas transfer case.

Part 1

- 1. Confirm that your Tazer JL Mini is running the current firmware.
- 2. Install the Atlas Transfer Case.
- 3. Set the "DTCM" setting in the Offroad submenu to "Yes."
- 4. Navigate to the Transfer Case Low Ratio "4 Low" option in the Performance submenu.
- 5. Set your Transfer Case Low Ratio "4 Low" to match the Atlas transfer case.

Part 2 (392 & 4XE only)

NOTE: The 2023 392 REQUIRES a DTCM module from the 2023 Rubicon 2.0 Turbo

- 1. HOLD the steering wheel Left Arrow button and PULL the high-beam stalk towards you with your left hand and TAP the Cruise Cancel button with your right hand.
- 2. The EVIC dash screen will read "FullTCase: Yes." Select this option and it will change to "FullTCase: No."
- 3. Perform a Full Reboot and two sleep cycles as described on the Critical Information page of the manual.

The transfer case is now set to part-time in order to work with the Atlas Transfer Case.

1. Perform a Full Reboot and two sleep cycles as described on the Critical Information page of the manual.
